Year 8 Fieldwork Day Exploring Ecosystems:

- **8X on Tuesday 16th June 2026**
- **8Y on Wednesday 17th June 2026**

A fieldwork day has been organised for our Year 8 pupils to investigate ecosystems within the school grounds and the surrounding area. This will involve a short walk into the village to visit two different field sites, where pupils will carry out a range of different ecological sampling techniques. The activities will take place within the usual school hours. Break and lunch times will remain as normal.

Pupils should arrive at school in non-uniform and must be suitably dressed for the activities to be able to take part. Please be aware that kit could get very muddy.

- **Long trousers (shorts, skirts, jeans are not suitable)**
- **Waterproof jacket**
- **Walking boots, wellingtons or old trainers (open-toed shoes are not suitable)**
- **Spare shoes/trainers to wear in school**
