Dear Parents/Carers

Year 8 End of Year Activity Day Tuesday 14th July 2026: AZTEC Upton Warren

The end of year trip for Year 8 pupils will be a day out at AZTEC, Upton Warren in Bromsgrove. During the day, pupils will be able to take part in a fun 'Aqua Park' activity and also a land-based challenge and/or another water-based activity with a qualified instructor from the centre.

We hope the pupils will take part fully and that it will be a day to remember and enjoy. We will be back before the end of the school day to allow pupils to catch buses home. Pupils will need some suitable items of clothing and specific items for the day which are listed on the next page. Pupils also need to bring any medication, asthma inhalers, sun protection, a packed lunch and plenty of water for the day.

The cost of the trip is £39.10 per child and covers all transport, hire of equipment and qualified activity instruction at the venue. Payment should be made through ParentPay by choosing the appropriate option: 'Year 8 End of Year Activity Day'. Through selecting this option, you will also need to provide consent for the trip and acknowledgement that the school currently holds the correct emergency contact details and allergy information for your child on My Child At School (MCAS). If you wish to check or change any information, please log-in to the MCAS app and select the 'Data Collection Form' option or email changes directly to the school - office@bredon.worcs.sch.uk. We request that all necessary payments are made by Friday 12th June 2026.

Any pupil eligible for Pupil Premium will not be charged for the visit. Please just log-in to ParentPay and choose the 'Year 8 End of Year Activity Day - Pupil Premium' option and confirm consent before Friday 12th June 2026. We will organise lunches for pupils in receipt of Free School Meals and who would like a lunch following your selected choices as you complete the ParentPay option.

Kit List for the Day

Water Based Activities

- Swimming shorts/costumes, with other suitable covering garments.
- Wetsuit, if you prefer to wear your own. The centre will provide these for every pupil – they are sterilised in between uses with a special cleaning dip solution.
- Paddle water shoes or pumps, if you have them. If not, an old pair of trainers will be fine.
- An appropriately-sized plastic bag for any wet kit and wet trainers.
- A towel.
- A change of dry clothes suitable for outdoor activity, such as tracksuit bottoms, shorts, thicker leggings, or camping trousers.
- It is advisable to bring a waterproof, lightweight jacket in case of showers as well for water and land-based activity.

Land Based Activities

- Comfortable and flexible clothing for moving around the outdoors in - no jeans or overly tight/short shorts. Tracksuit bottoms, leggings or outdoor pursuit trousers are fine.
- A packed lunch and full water bottle.
- Sun protection lotion.
- Sunhat.
- Any personal medications, including EpiPen or asthma inhaler, where relevant. Please fill out any medical information on the previous page and return to BHA office.

Mobile phone use during the day

Phone use must be treated like any normal school day and should be off and in the bottom of bags. These are only for use on school buses on the way home from school, not between school and the venue. We would suggest not bringing one if at all possible, and the school accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage.

Please ensure your child is fully equipped and prepared in advance of the day.
