1. Enrichment feedback – quite a few people don't seem to have been given first choice but restrictions (eg. Staffing and rooming) were understood.

Possibility of lunchtime clubs to go alongside enrichment – also giving Year 6 chance to trial activities before choosing at KS3.
Give Year 8 priority.
2. Zero Hero – nice idea but pupils who already had sanction are less focused on doing well.
Spring and summer term suggestions for activities – picnic and sports (weather dependent).
3. **School Poet Laureate** – to represent school and create poetry of milestone events
To be run as competition – could be judged by School Council.
Competition to be before Christmas – pupils can enter by writing a poem about BHA or an issue that affects BHA.
4. Aldi competition in DT – we've collected the stickers but now need to write something catchy about what our lasting health legacy will be if we win £20,000 – could be discussed in form times – pupils who come up with good suggestions be given HPs.
