13/6/22	Anne Frank – part two	<p>Using the information collected last lesson you are going to create an information booklet teaching Year 6 pupils about Anne Frank and who she was.</p> <p>You can do this by hand or on computer.</p> <p>You could even link in how she has inspired people such as Malala (they both talk about how books are more important and powerful than weapons).</p>
20/6/22	Guru Nanak – Inspirational Leader	<p>Guru Nanak PPT – follow the tasks through the PPT</p> <p>Guru Nanak Video sheet – fill in when watching the video clips in PPT</p> <p>Read the Guru Nanak stories sheet and answer the linked questions (they are on the sheet)</p>

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<b>27/6/22</b>	Nick Vujicic – his story: an inspiration	<p>Nick Vujicic PPT Work through the tasks on the PPT – watch the video too (there are also lots more of his on Youtube) Jigsaw piece for final task</p> <p>Can you find out what religion he is and how this has helped him in his approach to life?</p>
<b>4/7/22 &amp; 11/7/22</b>	<p>Inspirational person – End of term project</p> <p>You can choose a person to create your piece of work about – it will be like a mini-gallery of their life, how religion has impacted their choices and how they inspire others</p> <p>There are choices in the planning booklet if you are struggling to think of someone</p>	<p>Creating a mini gallery of your chosen person (your mini gallery can be inside something like a Happy Meal box – see link for example <a href="https://twitter.com/KarlDuke8/status/1385606774535987207">https://twitter.com/KarlDuke8/status/1385606774535987207</a> - but can also be presented in other ways too)</p> <p>You need a combination of pictures and information (see instruction booklet – summer project 2022 - for key information you need to include)</p>
