Year 6	English	During the autumn term, pupils will be set a range of spelling, grammar and punctuation tasks to complete over the week for up to an hour per week. This will mainly be through the online platforms, 'SATs Bootcamp' and 'Spelling Frame.' Pupils are also expected to read for a minimum of thirty minutes each day to build their fluency and stamina, as well as their reading for pleasure habit. From January, pupils will be set longer tasks, including extended writing tasks, as they build their skills as an independent writer for their writing portfolio. A small number of pupils will be placed on bespoke home learning timetables to meet specific needs or placed on specialised programmes to support additional needs, such as dyslexia.									
	Maths	Throughout the year, pupils will typically be set two home learning tasks per week by their class teacher. These will be a mixture of written tasks, revision activities from the Ready, Set, Go! Book and learning activities. Some of these will be online activities using 'SATs Bootcamp'. Each of these tasks should take a maximum of 30 minutes (one hour across the week). Pupils will also be expected to undertake regular times tables practice using 'TTRockstars' - a minimum of 30 minutes of game play is expected across the week.									

Please note that Food Preparation and Nutrition will set equipment and ingredient lists as home learning.
