Task: Write the story based on this picture.

Questions to Think About:

- What do the hands represent?
- Who put them there?
- Are the colours important?
- Where are these hands?
- How long ago were they put there?
- What can't we see?

Sentence Challenge

Use a pair of commas, dashes or brackets to add detail to a sentence e.g. The multi-coloured hands – that interlocked and overlapped – covered every part of the wall.
