

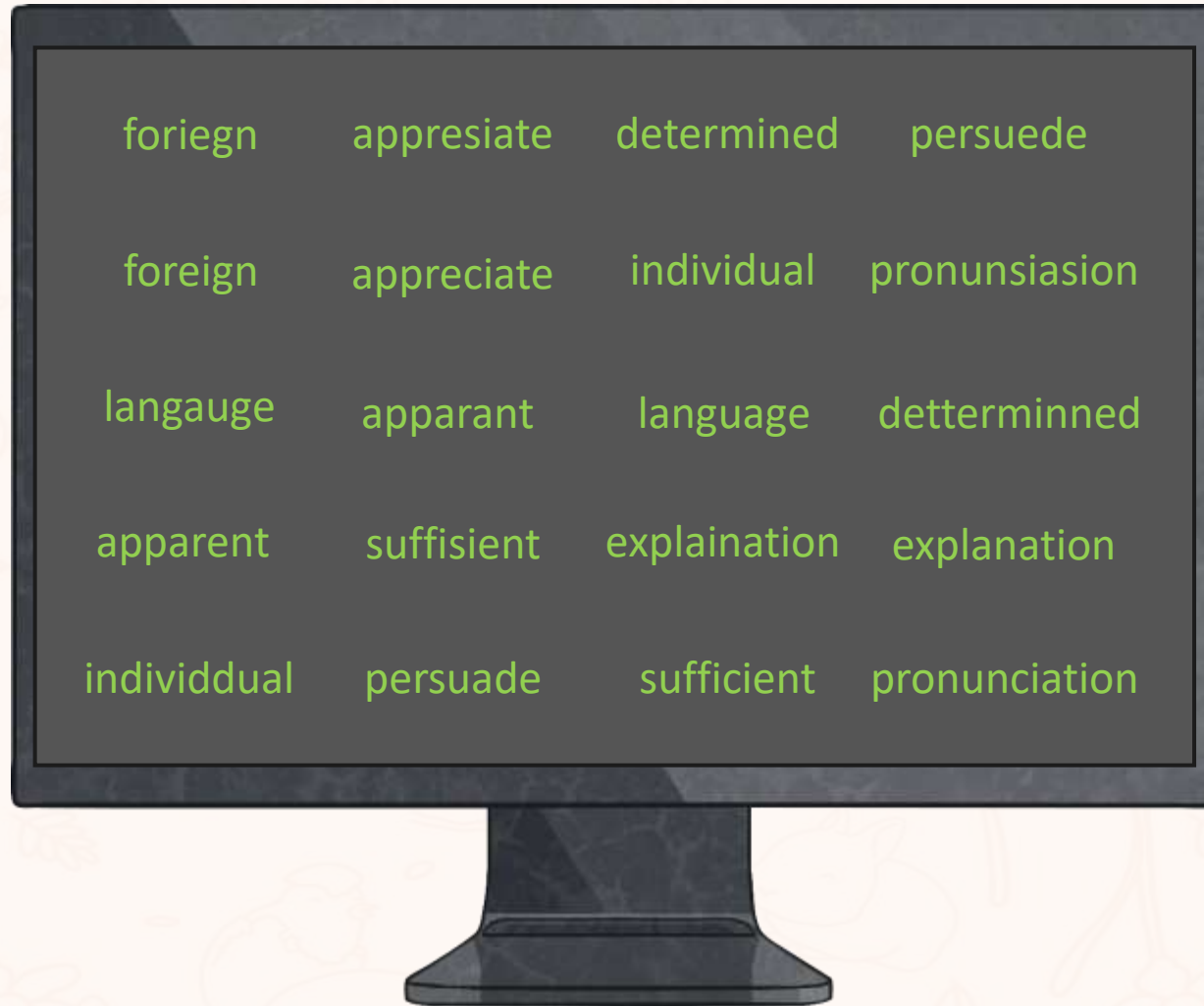
Statutory Spelling Challenge Words
